Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's sanction letter No.9-1/72-PR.I dated 7th September, 1973, I am directed to convey the approval of the President to grant-in-aid of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy five thousand only) as second instalment of the grant approved for 1973-74.

2. The grant is subject to the following further terms and conditions and also the conditions laid down in this Ministry's sanction letter of even number dated 7th September, 1973.

(a) The Centre shall execute a bond in the prescribed form for the grant of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy five thousand only) and submit the same before the grant can be released. The bond should be signed by an officer of the Centre, duly authorised by the governing body by a Resolution, an attested copy of which should also be enclosed with the bond.

(b) The accounts of the grant so far as its utilization is concerned shall be open to a test-check by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India at his discretion. Intimation about the conduct of such audit will be sent to the Centre as and when necessary. The accounts shall also be subject to a test-check by an officer deputed by the Government of India, whenever such an occasion arises.

(c) After the close of the financial year and in any case not later than June 30, 1974, a statement of accounts for the whole year, duly audited by a chartered Accountant or a Government Auditor, along with a utilization certificate certifying that the grant has been utilised for the purpose for which it is sanctioned, should be sent to the Ministry.

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(d) The Centre shall maintain an audited record of all assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the Government grant. Such assets shall not be disposed of, encumbered, or utilised for purposes other than these for which the grant is given without prior sanction of the Government of India.

(e) The amount sanctioned in this grant is to be utilised by or up to March 31, 1974.

(f) Further, the grant will be subject to a review of the work of the Centre by the Government.

3. Any amount of the grant-in-aid remaining unspent during the current financial year shall be refunded to the Government of India immediately after the close of the financial year.

4. If the Central Government have any reasons to believe that the sanctioned amount has not been utilised for the approved purposes, the sanctioned amount shall have to be refunded by the Centre.


5. The amount is debitable to the Head of Account Major Head 28 Demand No. 26 A. Education-A. 4 General-A. 4(2) Grants-in-aid, Contributions etc. A. 4(2)(15) Other Institutions - Centre for Studies in Social Sciences, Calcutta, 1973-74(Plan). The amount under this new sub-head will be re-appropriated in due course.

6. The amount of Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees Seventy five thousand only) sanctioned above will be drawn from the Treasury Officer, New Delhi, before March 31, 1974 by Shri P.S. Balakrishnan, Under Secretary, Ministry of Education and Social Welfare, who is the Drawing and Disbursing Officer for the purposes of grants-in-aid and paid to the grantee through an RTR.

7. The pattern of this grant has been approved by the Ministry of Finance and it is certified that this sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles as approved by the Ministry of Finance.

8. This sanction is being accorded under the delegated powers and with the concurrence of Director (IF) under Dy. No. 7105/73-IF.I dated 7.11.1973.
