The CSSSC, a premier research institution under the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) with advanced-level teaching programmes, invites applications to fill up vacancies, including backlog vacancies for reserved categories, for the posts of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in the following disciplines: Cultural Studies, Development/ Environmental Studies, Gender Studies, Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Sociology, and Social Anthropology. The total posts to be filled up are: Professor – 6 (Gen – 3, SC – 2, ST – 1), Associate Professor – 1 (SC) and Assistant Professor – 4 (Gen – 2, OBC – 1, ST –1). Applicants must have a record of significant academic activities and research publications and should have a Ph D in any of the social sciences or humanities disciplines.
