**“Intimate Internationalism:
Micro-Macrohistories of Performing Arts and Socialist Selves”**

The Performing Arts Ensemble of the Hungarian People's Army toured China in the autumn of 1956. This project explores the intersections between memory, oral history, conventional archival evidence, as well as photographic and cinematic mnemo-technique, to reconstruct some of the immediate lived experiences of the participants in this tour in the context of sudden and momentous macro-political change. Among other media, the presentation includes a short film narrating the tour, shot on location, by the great Hungarian film director Miklós Jancsó.
